For almost 20 years, Wildflower has been dedicated to supporting children and their families who have experienced the death of a parent, helping them to recover, rebuild, and thrive.

In Massachusetts, an estimated 1 in 14 children will experience the loss of a parent by the age of 18.

We have provided 1,000 summer camp experiences to 200 children in and around Greater Boston. Our support of these families is not limited to just the summer. We have a dedicated group of volunteers who maintain communication with the surviving parent or caregiver offering personalized year-round services, vocational programs, and camp-to-college programs to our older children.
